Dear Sir/ Madam,

AICTE has endeavoured to process the applications for grant of approval to all its courses in ONLINE mode since past many years. Furthering the cause, all applications shall be required to be signed digitally using a digital signature from the upcoming Approval Process for AY 2021-22.


It is to inform that there are authorized / licensed certifying agencies to issue Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA). The details of the licensing agencies along with their contact details are available on the web site of Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA).

Therefore, all Heads of AICTE approved Institutions are advised to approach the concerned authorized / certified agencies of Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) and procure the DSCs as early as possible before the start of portal for A/Y 2021-22, in Feb 2021.

You are also informed that for any Trust / Society / Company / Only four authorised DSCs shall be permitted namely i.e. President / Chairman of the Trust / Secretary / Treasurer / Head of the Institution.

It shall be the responsibility of the promoters to ensure the safety and validity of the DSCs authorised by name. Any change in the incumbent of the DSC shall be informed to the Council immediately. AICTE shall bear no responsibility in the event of misuse of DSC for its approval process.

The same may be treated as having the highest priority.
