



<b>1.1</b>	<b>Objectives</b>
	<p>STTP-SFURTI intends to conduct faculty and student trainings through financial assistance from AICTE to enable faculty members and students in the field of technical education to introspect and learn techniques that can help prepare faculty and students to impart their research work in the development of small-scale business for the nation.</p> <p><b>All India Council For Technical Education (AICTE) and Indian Micro Enterprises Development Foundation (IMEDF)</b> is conducting <b>STTP-SFURTI</b> Program. This is a special purpose vehicle for developing alternatives group that accelerates the development of micro-enterprises. IMEDF is also the nodal agency of Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, Government of India for the development of clusters under STTP-SFURTI (Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries).</p> <p>The main objective of the STTP-SFURTI is as follows:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>To understand Scheme of Fund for Regeneration of Traditional Industries (SFURTI).</b></li><li>• <b>To train the students and faculty in identifying and presenting a project proposal.</b></li><li>• <b>To enhance and sharpen their skills to develop a viable detailed project report.</b></li><li>• <b>To understand resource management for building a project with technological and social innovations.</b></li><li>• <b>To develop in depth understanding of project management, resolve challenges faced in sustainable rural economic development and derive lessons on social, economic and environmental impacts.</b></li></ul>
<b>1.2</b>	<b>Eligibility</b>
	(a) All faculty members and students in areas of technical education in AICTE approved institutions are eligible to participate.
	(b) Maximum 2 programs in each state mentioned below will be conducted as part of STTP-SFURTI: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Jharkhand</li><li>2. Arunachal Pradesh</li><li>3. <b>1.3</b>	<b>Duration of Programme</b>

		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The course will be of two weeks (12 days duration) divided into two phases.</li> <li>2. Phase 1 shall consist of 10 days online training for faculty/Students and phase 2 shall consist of two days of practical training cum visit to a SFURTI Cluster.</li> <li>3. The dates for the courses shall be informed 1 month prior.</li> </ol>
		<b>Course Distribution</b>
		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. There will be a minimum of two sessions every day of two hours each.</li> <li>2. The online classes will start every day from 0900 h (Monday to Saturday).</li> <li>3. The course capacity will be 30 faculty members per STTP-SFURTI.</li> </ol>
<b>1.4</b>		<b>Limit of funding</b>
		Rs.Four Lakhs
<b>1.5</b>		<b>Disbursement of the Funds</b>
	(a)	The full amount of the grant sanctioned shall be released after successful conduct of the program to IMEDF.
	(b)	The amount spent by the institute on the conduct of STTP-SFURTI shall be adjusted on the basis of utilization certificate and detailed expenditure statement submitted by the IMEDF on the prescribed format along with other mandatory documents viz feedback form, copy of proceedings and completion report etc.
<b>1.6</b>		<b>Processing Methodology</b>
		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. AICTE will share the details of Faculty members detailed to attend 1 week before of the program.</li> <li>2. The SFURTI Cluster of IMEDF will host the Course.</li> <li>3. The Faculty/Students will report at cluster on the day of practical visit on time. The Visit cum Practical training will start at 0800 Hours. The dispersal shall take place at 1600 h on next day ( ` 12<sup>th</sup> day of the program).</li> <li>4. IMEDF will be responsible for boarding, lodging and transport.</li> <li>5. AICTE &amp; IMEDF will issue Certificates to those completing the course successfully. Grading will be as per AICTE Guidelines i.e. 80 percent attendance and 60 percent-qualified marks mandatory for certificate participants.</li> <li>6. A formal sanction letter will be issued by AICTE to IMEDF on acceptance of these instructions.</li> <li>7. Payment shall be made to IMEDF within 30 days of completion of each course.</li> <li>8. After completion of the program, IMEDF will share the details of Attendance and Marks scored by students within 7 days of termination of the course with recommendations for issue of Certificates to successful candidates. (Criteria will be 80% attendance, 60% marks and Field visit).</li> <li>9. AICTE will issue Certificates to Students on basis of Recommendations of IMEDF Faculty.</li> <li>10. IMEDF will share a 3-4 Slide PPT on termination of each course highlighting the salient aspects of each course, Attendance, results, Field visit and outcomes in terms of DPRs etc.</li> </ol>

		A test will be conducted at the end of the Programme by IMEDF

	<b>Instructions for Faculty/Students</b>
	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. All faculty/students will register for the online-based course as per the details provided by AICTE.</li><li>2. All faculty/students will be required to log in everyday online through the online platform and UTS Learning Platform.</li><li>3. Faculty/students should be self-contained for writing material.</li><li>4. The attendance will be marked for everyday from 09.00 AM. Any faculty/student absent for more than one day shall be withdrawn from the course.</li><li>5. Appropriate weightage shall be given to exams/exercises /assignments at the end of each day. The Certificate shall be awarded only to those qualifying in these.</li><li>6. IMEDF will submit the feedback form at the end of the training program.</li></ol>
